

Public Health Advisory

To the residents living at the outskirts of
the Missisquoi bay or using the bay for leisure
activities

Longueuil, 30th of July 2002.

A considerable quantity of cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) is actually present in the Missisquoi bay. Cyanobacteria and the toxins they produce may cause health effects.

The following **recommendations** must therefore be applied to protect your health:

⇒ **Avoid all contact with untreated water** from the bay (bathing, aquatic sports, for shower or bath use) **if there is foam** on the surface or if the water is **murky or greenish**.

⇒ **Do not drink untreated water** from the bay
