


Variable-leaved watermilfoil - a relative of Eurasian watermifoil *and* Lake Champlain's newest invader - has recently been found growing in Missisquoi Bay

- **Check** boat, trailer, motor and other equipment for attached plant or animal material.
- **Remove** *all* plant and animal material and discard in the trash.
- **Drain** all water from boat, boat engine, and other equipment.
- Rinse all boat and trailer parts with tap water (preferably hot, high pressure) or
 Dry boat, trailer and equipment out of water and in sun for at least five days.
