As a partner of the U.S. National Park Service (NPS), the Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership (CVNHP) participates in the NPS *Passport Stamp Program* where visitors log their experiences at parks, landmarks and heritage areas across the country. In celebration of the 100th anniversary of the NPS in 2016, the CVNHP produced this commemorative *Stamp Cancellation Passport* for 11 locations throughout the national heritage area. These sites represent the arts, outdoor recreation, land conservation, military history, commerce, natural history, wildlife conservation, and many other aspects of the CVNHP. So, get your passport stamped for exploration, inspiration and adventure!

Individuals* who acquire all 11 of the passport stamps can receive a limited-edition, commemorative coin marking the 2016 centennial of the NPS.

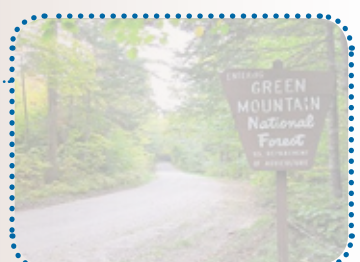
