

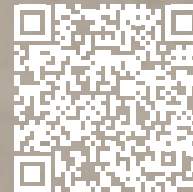

FREE PARKING available on campus in Lot 02-Hawkins and Lot 03-AuSable only. Cars parked in other campus parking areas will be ticketed.



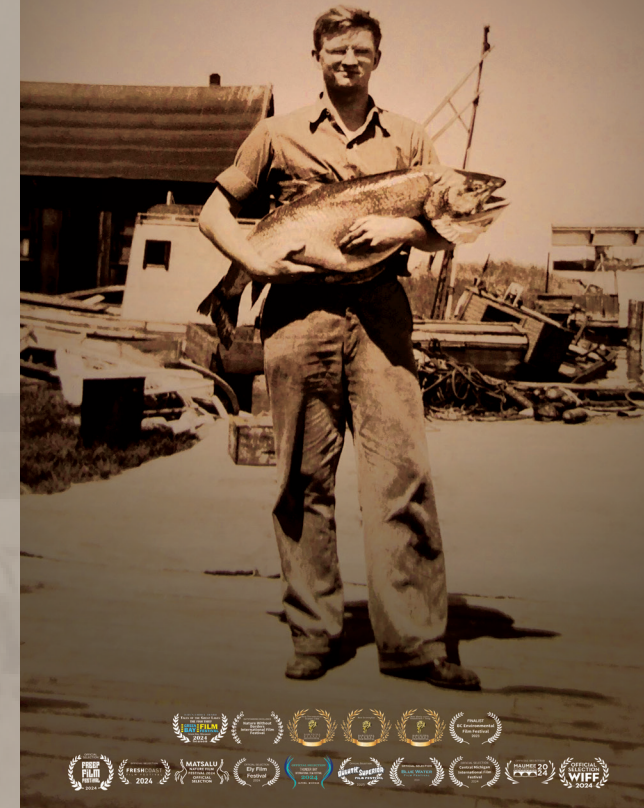
